

Prize hunt – Rules

1. The prize hunt will take place during a 4-week period (week 37-40), in which the student will be able to complete different challenges and then participate in the lottery each week. The competition is carried out by Örebro Student Union together with a project group (in which Örebro University and Örebro Municipality are represented).
2. **The person participating in the prize hunt competition must...**
 - a.... be a registered student at Örebro University.
 - b have purchased a regular membership of Örebro Student Union for (at least) the autumn semester 2020.
3. 10 general challenges are published on the website every Monday. In addition to these 10 challenges, there will be 5 Kårsection-specific challenges. Also the international Master's students will have their own specific challenges that will apply throughout the competition.
 - a. You can choose in which week you want to compete with these Kårsection-specific / Master's specific challenges.
 - b. Each challenge must be documented with a photo or video (see the challenge).
 - c. You can compete with a maximum of 7 challenges per week.
4. **To participate** in the competition you need to fill in and submitting the form that can be found on the website (www.orebostudentkar.se/prisjakten/). The Master's specific challenges can just be found in the English form. You need to fill in your name, e-mail address and which challenge you have been completed. Each competitor fills in a form separately.
 - a. The form will be closed every **Sunday at 23.59**, after that no form will be accepted in the competition or be in the lottery for any prizes.
 - b. Fill in a maximum of 7 completed challenges in your form. Additional challenges will be deleted.
 - c. A competitor can only compete with one form per week. If more forms are submitted from a competitor during one and the same week, only the first entry will be included in the competition.
5. **The draw** will take place after each completed competition week, and the winners will be contacted via the **email** they provided when filling in the form. Each completed challenge will receive a **lottery number**, and thus if you have completed more than 1 challenge can win several prizes during the same week. The lottery will take place via a random number generator.
 - a. The winners will be presented on Wednesday after the forms have been sent on the website of Örebro Student Union.
 - b. The winners contacted need to respond via email within 5 business days to accept their prize. If the winner has not answered, the prize will go to another lottery.

c. In order to collect the prize, the competitor must show that the winning challenge has been completed. If the competitor can't provide a proof, the prize will go to the next person.

d. The winner must also present a valid membership in Örebro Student Union for the autumn of 2020.
